Fast Facts: Reproductive Health and Family Planning in Atlantic County

- 1,595 cases of bacterial sexually transmitted diseases in 2015¹ - a **19.8 percent increase** since 2009²
- **O percent change** in the number of breast cancer cases among all Atlantic County women since 2009 - compared to a -25.6 percent decrease for Black women and a -11.8 percent decrease for Latinas³
- 1,414 people living with HIV in Atlantic County in 20154
- 17,240 women in need of publicly funded contraceptive services and supplies, a **5 percent increase** since 2010⁵
