

Fast Facts: Reproductive Health and Family Planning in Cape May County

- **369 cases** of bacterial sexually transmitted diseases in 2015¹ - a **47 percent increase** since 2009²
- **-5.5 percent decrease** in the number of breast cancer cases among all Cape May County women since 2009³
- **212 people** living with HIV in Cape May County in 2015⁴
- **4,820 women** in need of publicly funded contraceptive services and supplies, a **5 percent increase** since 2010⁵
