## Fast Facts: Reproductive Health and Family Planning in Hunterdon County

- 207 cases of bacterial sexually transmitted diseases in 2015<sup>1</sup> a 38.9 percent increase since 2009<sup>2</sup>
- **0.8 percent increase** in the number of breast cancer cases among all Hunterdon County women since 2009<sup>3</sup>
- 159 people living with HIV in Hunterdon County in 2015<sup>4</sup>
- 3,580 women in need of publicly funded contraceptive services and supplies, a 4 percent increase since 2010<sup>5</sup>
